## A. COURSE:

## Culture Site Guide: LEVEL 4 (SAQA ID: TG/CultSiteGd/4/0031) (W Cape Province Regional Guide)

## Entry requirement:

- Proof of a minimum, NQF Level 3 (Grade 11) pass or equivalent.
- English language proficiency and access to a computer and internet are mandatory for the online courses.

- Full time course two weeks of contact time ending with the exam on last day, followed by 5 weeks of assignment writing.
- Online course theory done in own time prior to attending 1 week of practical contact time, ending with the exam on last day, followed by 5 weeks of assignment writing.
- The Phase 1 qualifies you as a Culture Site Guide, for the Phase 1 regions of the Western Cape.
- The Phase 2 qualifies you for the Phase 2 regions of the Western Cape Province. The Phase 2 exam is included free of charge if written within 7 weeks of the Phase 1 exam. (Self-study).
